2015 Legislative Dates

June 5 Last day for bills to pass house of origin

June 15
Budget Bill must be passed by midnight

July 17 Last day for policy committees to meet and report bills. Summer recess begins

Aug. 28 Last day for fiscal committees to meet and report bills

September 11 Last day for any bill to be passed

October 11 Last day for Governor to sign or veto bills passed by legislature

2015 Recycled Water Legislation

- AB 606 State Property Water Use
- AB 725 Recycled water: storm-induced overflow. SWRCB to adopt policy by 12/31/16 to maximize use of RW
- AB 888 Waste management: plastic microbeads
- AB 954 Water and Wastewater Loan & Grant Program
- AB 957 Increase Prop 1 \$ for water recycling & advanced treatment technology projects to \$725M
- AB 1463 Onsite Recycled Water: establish requirements

Other Water Legislation

- SB 47 Analyze synthetic turf for adverse health impacts
- SB 385 Water Agency compliance with Chromium 6
- SB 471 Water Energy GHG
- AB 585 Tax credit for outdoor landscape improvements
- AB 603 Tax credit for lawn replacement
- AB 1173 Backflow prevention testing: certification

Budget Trailer Bills

- Implementing language of the California Budget
- Several Budget Trailer Bills being considered including:
 - Permit Fees
 - CEQA exemptions for recycled water & storm water projects
 - Submeter requirements for new buildings
 - Water System Consolidation
 - Drought Monitoring and Reporting
 - Drought Expanded Local Authority and Penalties

National Legislation Update

- Water in the 21st Century Act
- WOTUS Regulations
- Water Infrastructure Resiliency and Sustainability Act

Governor's Drought Emergency

- 1st mandatory restriction in CA history
- Require 25% mandatory urban use reduction
- Conservation reductions exclude recycled water
- Maximum irrigation of 2 X Week
- No Lawn watering for 48 hours after rainfall
- Update state landscape ordinance

Title 17 and 22 changes

- Subcommittee Identified priorities for revisions
- DDW reviewed proposed Title 22 changes
- DDW reminded us of other high priorities & limited staff
- DDW has concerns about removing 4-year testing of dual plumbed facilities & suggested alternative methods
- Subcommittee to prepare more detailed justification
- DDW is open to stakeholder involvement
- Subcommittee to continue to pursue revisions with DDW
