August 12, 2014 Legislation & Regulation Update

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Important 2014 Legislative Dates

- August 4 Legislature reconvenes from recess
- August 15 Last day for fiscal committee to meet& move bills to the Floor
- August 22 Last day to amend bills on the Floor
- August 31 Last day for each house to pass bills;
 Final recess begins
- September 30 Last day for Gov. to sign or veto bills
- November 4 General Election & ballot
- January 2015 Statutes take effect

AB 2282: Building Standards - Recycled Water Infrastructure (Gatto)

- Develop mandatory recycled water building standards for residential & commercial buildings for adoption in 2016
- State agencies conduct recycled water research including:
 - Potential indoor and outdoor applications
 - Recycled water systems and infrastructure costs
 - Estimated water savings
- Only applies to new construction
- Local jurisdiction maintain final discretion
- Strong support: Env., labor, builders, and others
- Last Amended: 8/5/14
- Last Action: 8/11/14 Re-referred to Com. on Apr for 8/14/14

AB 2417: CEQA Exemption for Recycled Water Pipelines (Nazarian)

- Exempts recycled water pipelines up to 8 miles in length for construction, installation, repair, replacement, etc.
- Must be within a public street, highway, or right-of-way
- Sponsor: ACWA , CMUA, & WateReuse
- Last Amended: 5/7/14
- File a NOE & hold public hearing for traffic mitigation
- Concerns: hearing, open space limits, trench size, etc.
- Last Action: 6/18/14 Hearing cancelled by author

AB 2636: CalConserve Water Use Efficiency Revolving Fund (Gatto)

- Establish sustainable funding source for water use efficiency and recycled water projects.
- DWR enter in to agreements with local governments or investor-owned utilities to set up programs
- Funds from Prop. 13, future bonds, GHG, and federal contributions
- Loans up to 25 years for DAC
- Last Amended: 6/30/14 non-substantive
- Last Action: 8/4/14 placed on suspense file; hearing scheduled for 8/14/14

Other Recycled Water Legislation

- SB 1014 Pharmaceutical waste: home generated
- AB 1699 Waste management: micro plastics
- AB 2071 Recycled water: pasture animals
- AB 2403 Local government: assessments, fees, & charges
- AB 2443 Duplication of service: mutual water companies
- AB 2712 Hazardous materials: OCWD

SB 1168: Groundwater Management (Pavley) & AB 1739 (Dickinson)

- Identify or form local GW sustainability agency
- Adopt sustainable groundwater management plan by 2020 for high or medium priority basins
- Coordinate multiple plans for GW basin
- Cover entire GW basin no unmanaged areas
- Report GW data to DWR annually by 2020
- Adjudicated basins exempt except for annual reporting
- Last Amended: 8/6/14
- Last Action: 8/7/14 Re-referred to Com. on Apr for 8/13/14

2014 Water Bond

- Existing \$11.2 B Water Bond scheduled for November ballot
- Deadline to place bond on November Ballot ~Aug 13, 2014
- Requires 2/3 vote to change & Governor's signature
- Include various amounts for recycled water and groundwater
- 11 bond proposals considered by legislature
- Governor request lower cost bond ~ \$6 B
 - Bay Delta Conservation Plan neutral
 - Protect existing water rights and area or origin
 - Funding eligibility requires urban or agricultural mgmt. plans
 - Propose \$450 M for water recycling
 - Propose \$ 2 B for storage continuously appropriated

Federal Legislative Update

- Water in the 21st Century Act
 - Strengthens EPA's WaterSense program
 - \$700 million for rebates
 - New EPA grant program for local water systems to conserve water, increase water efficiency or reuse water
- California Emergency Drought Relief Act of 2014
 - Passed Senate 5/22 and awaiting reconciliation
- Water Resource Reform Development Act (WRRDA)
 - Singed by President June 10, 2014
- FY 2014 Omnibus bill passed ~\$1T
 - Increased funding in WaterSMART and Title XVI
 - SRF Funding ~\$2.35B

New State Permits

- Statewide Recycled Water General Permit
 - Covers all non-potable reuse applications except groundwater recharge
- Groundwater Replenishment Reuse Project (GRRP) Permit
 - Planned use of recycled municipal wastewater for replenishing designated groundwater basin

Regulatory Update

Proposed amendment to Water Quality Control Plan for ocean waters to address desalination intakes and brine discharges

Consider salinity objective & potential impact to marine life

Public hearing scheduled for 8/19/14
