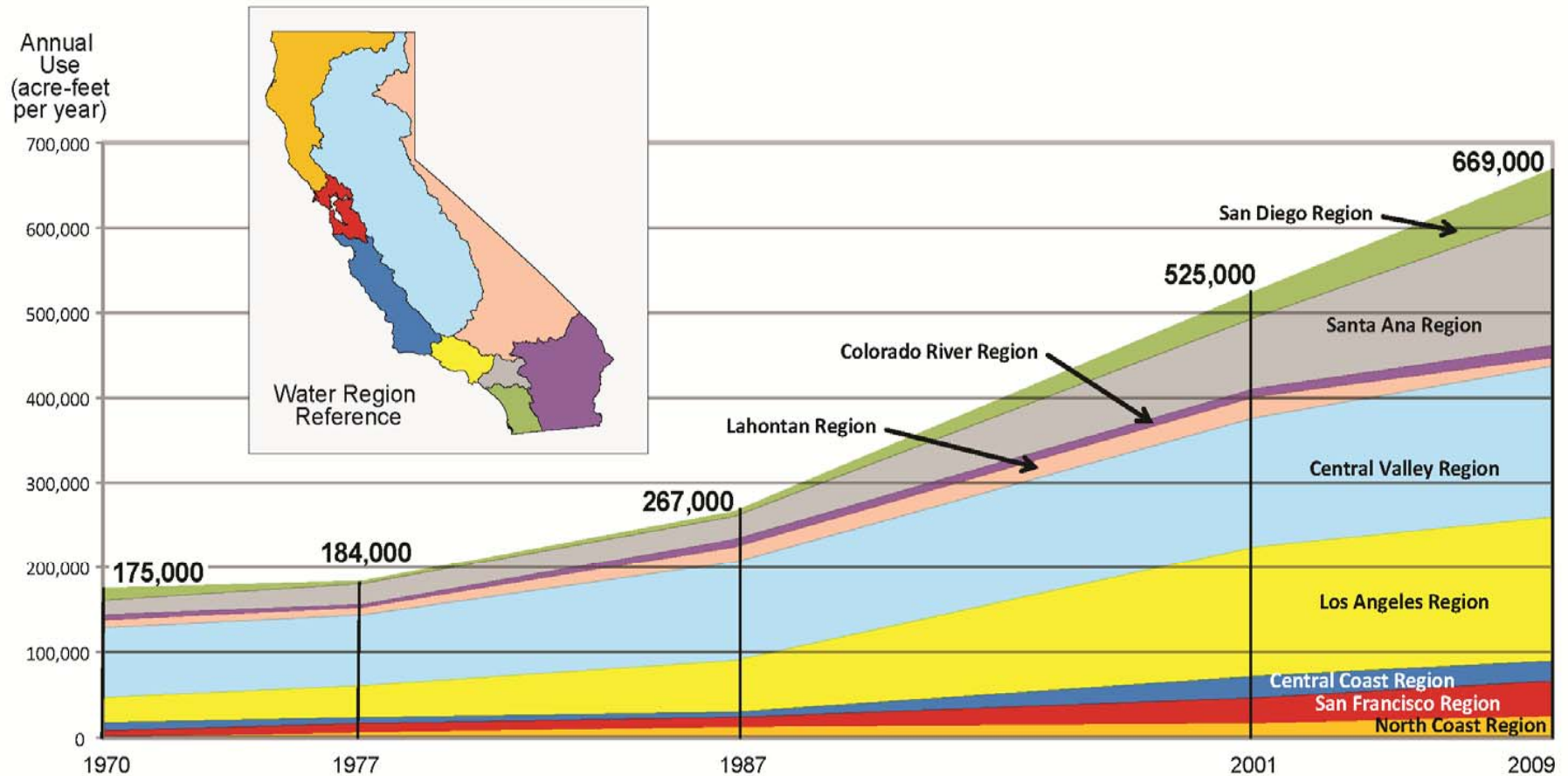
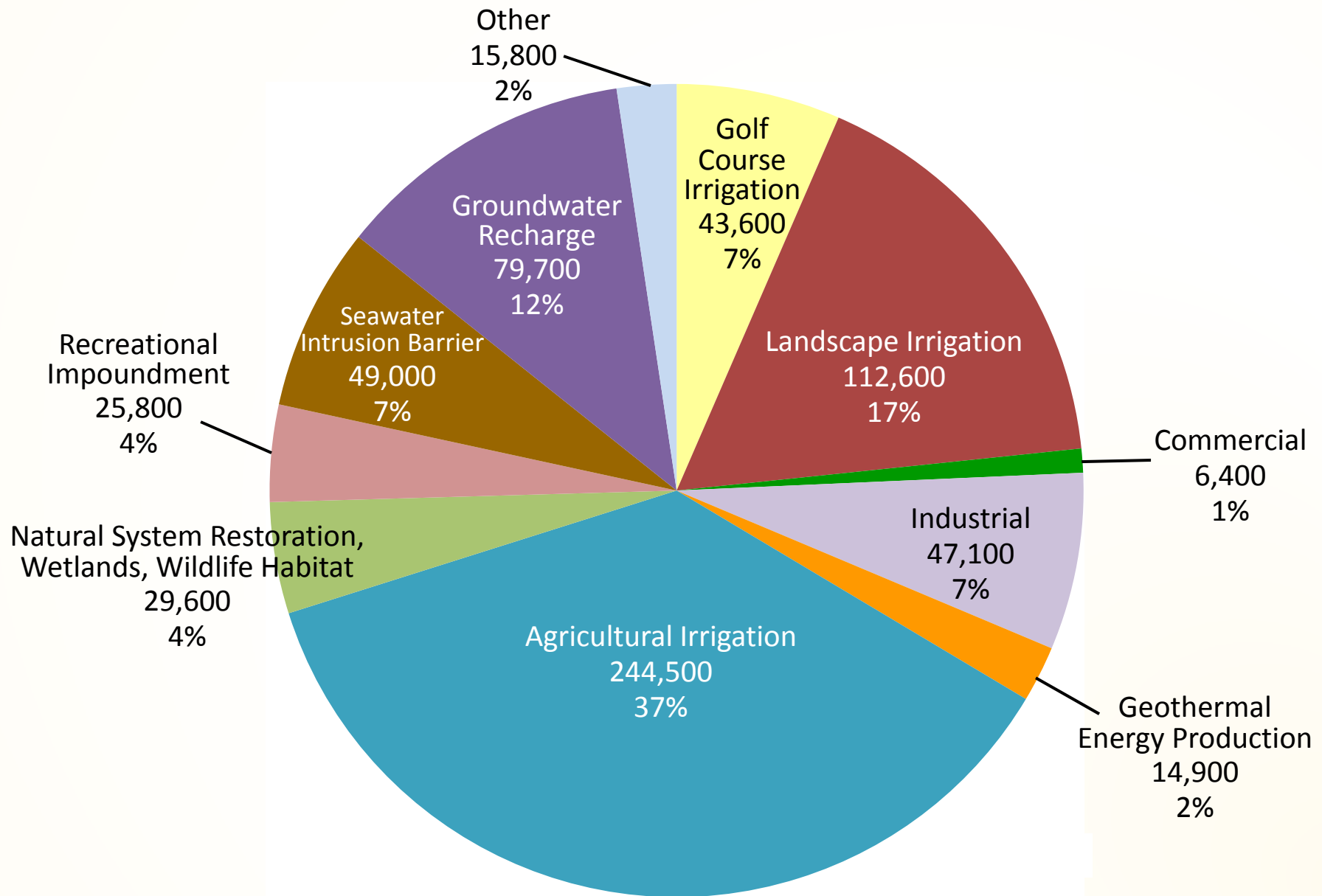


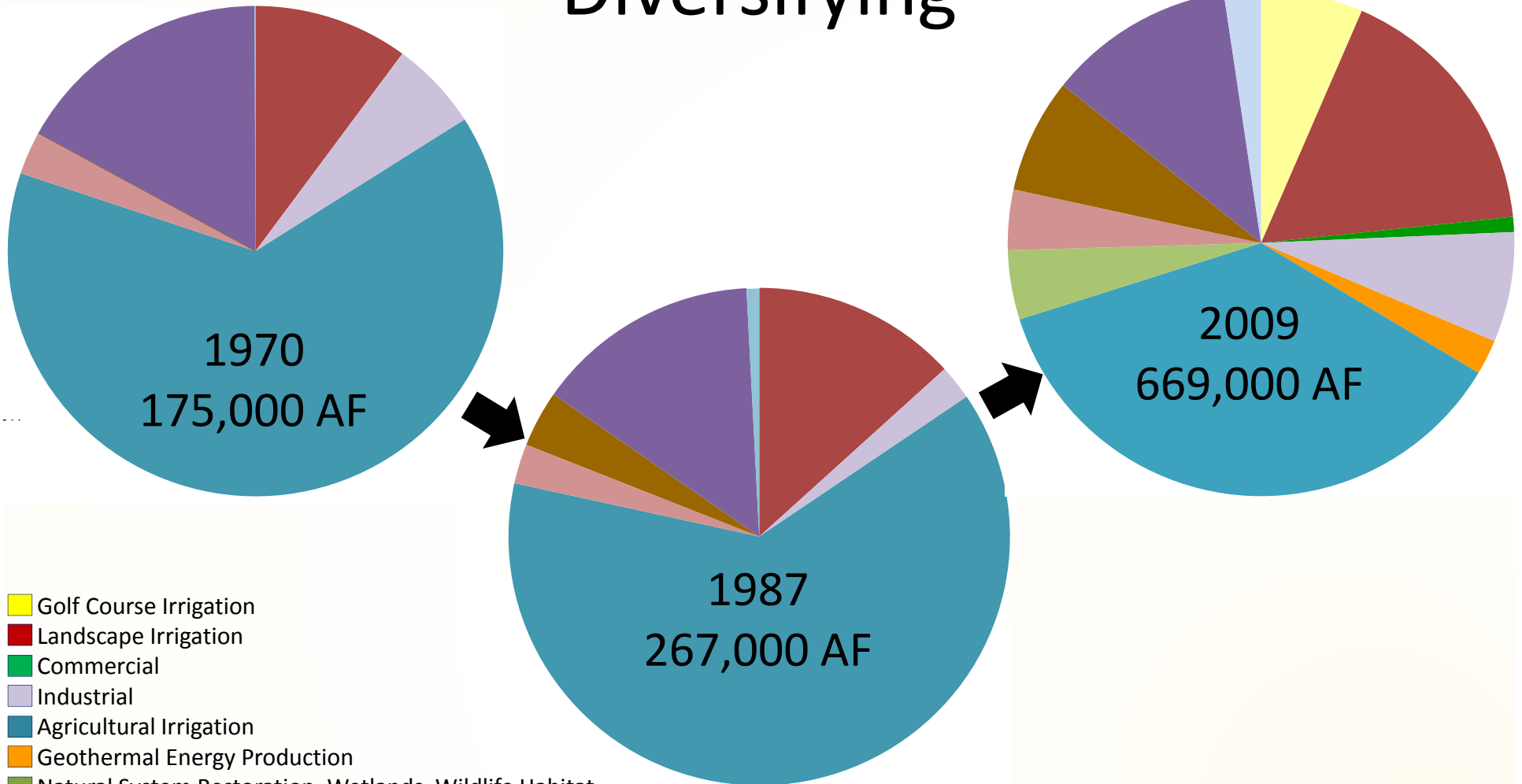
Municipal Recycled Water Use is Increasing



2009 Results: 669,000 acre-feet



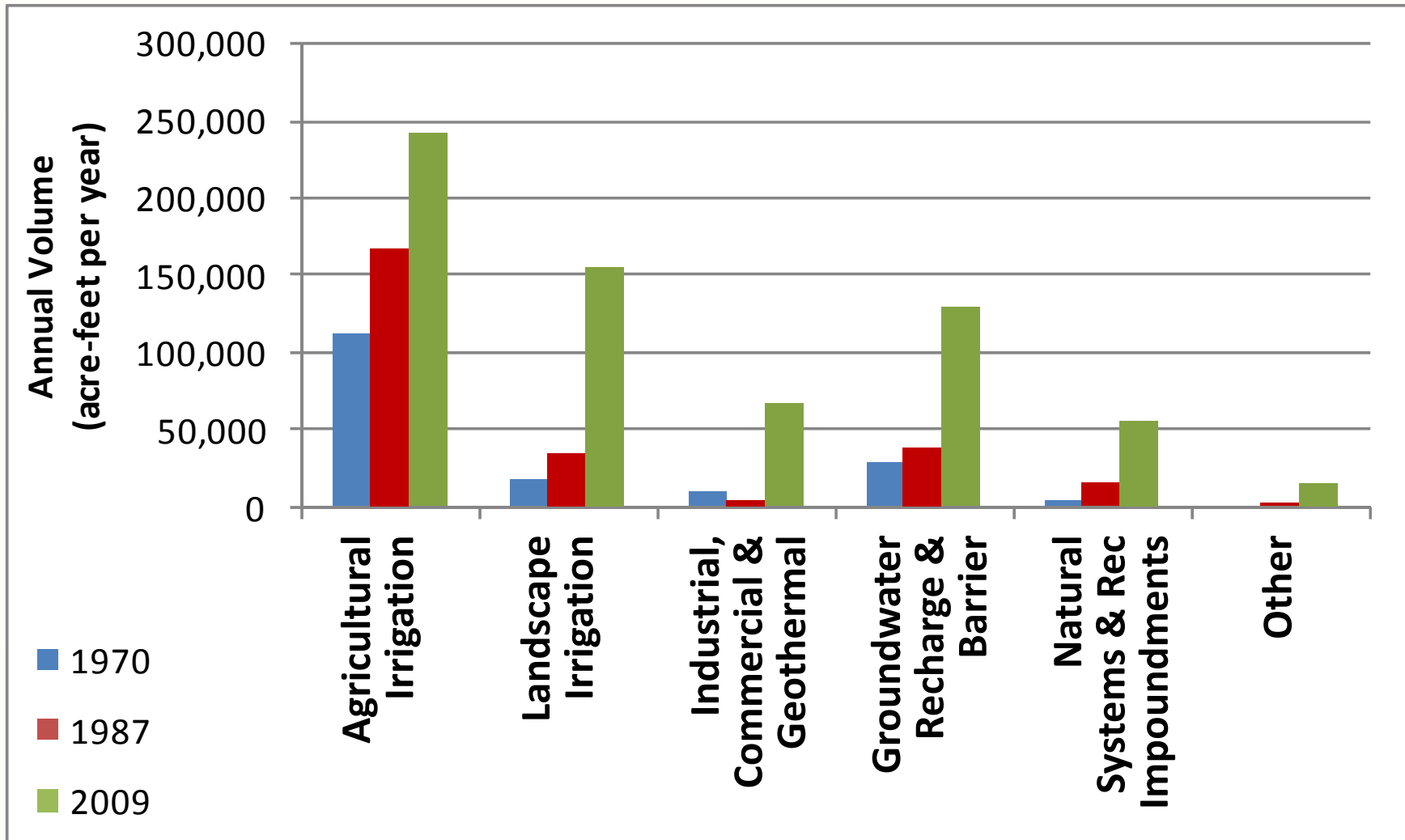
Municipal Recycled Water Use is Diversifying



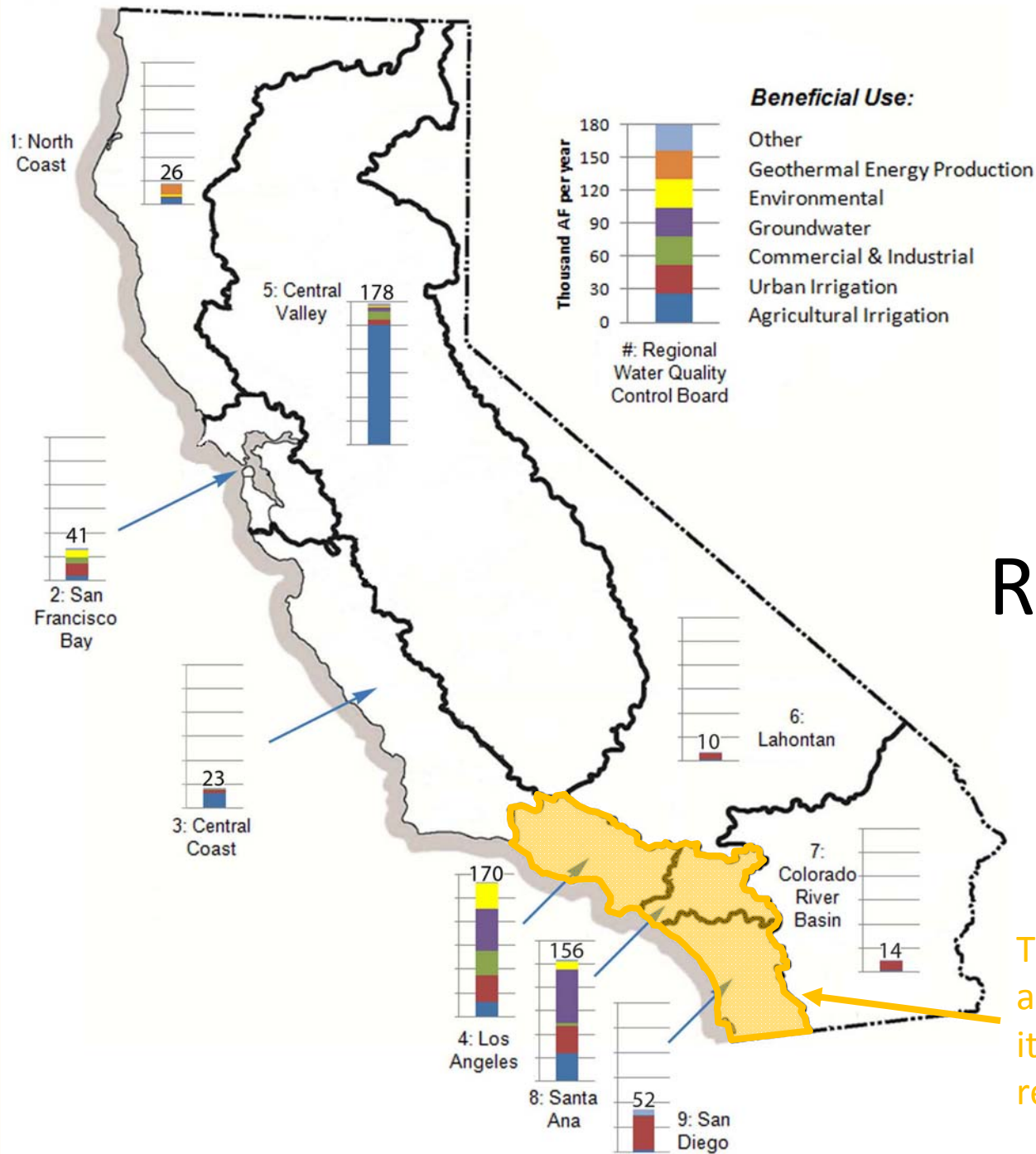
