TEXT REQUIREMENTS (total of 700-800 words, no more than 1,000)

- 1. Title
- 2. Summary 150 words
- 3. Objectives 125 words
- 4. Methods 150 words
- 5. Results to Date 150 words
- 6. Benefits to the Industry 150 words
- 7. Contact email address, phone number, affiliation/association, photo
- 8. Authors 15 words (include Co-Pls)
- 9. Acknowledgements 50 words (students, staff, supplier, etc.)
- 10. Images Two to four photos, graphs, tables, etc. (see below)

GRAPHIC FILE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Photos, graphs, tables sent in 300 dpi or vector based PDF with embedded fonts
- 2. Charts, tables and graphs must all have the same font, color and style
- 3. All images and charts to be sent as a jpg file
- 4. Minimum of two (2) images and not more than four (4) images
- 5. Simplify charts, graphs and tables so they are easy to read
- 6. Send one color headshot photo of yourself in jpg format

Poster design assistance and poster printing will be available to students and young professionals wishing to participate. Once received, we will insert your text and graphics into the poster template and then send to you for final approval. You will have 48 hours to review and return one (1) round of revisions. Once you receive the corrected poster, you will have 24 hours to approve. We must receive email confirmation of your approval to submit the poster into the contest. *Please note, once we have final approval no further changes can be accommodated.* The approved final poster will then be printed and shipped to Flagstaff for the symposium.
