Pure Water Monterey is an advanced water recycling and purification project to deliver potable water to the Peninsula and gather and deliver additional irrigation water to the growers in Northern Monterey County. It is a multi-region, multi-benefit project. What makes it unique is that it gathers not just wastewater, but also agricultural produce wash water, storm water, and used irrigation water. The project is environmentally preferred to a larger desalination plant because of lower carbon footprint, reduced discharges to the National Marine Sanctuary, and it cleans up discharges to the Salinas River. The project was referenced in Senator Feinstein's drought bill introduced in February.

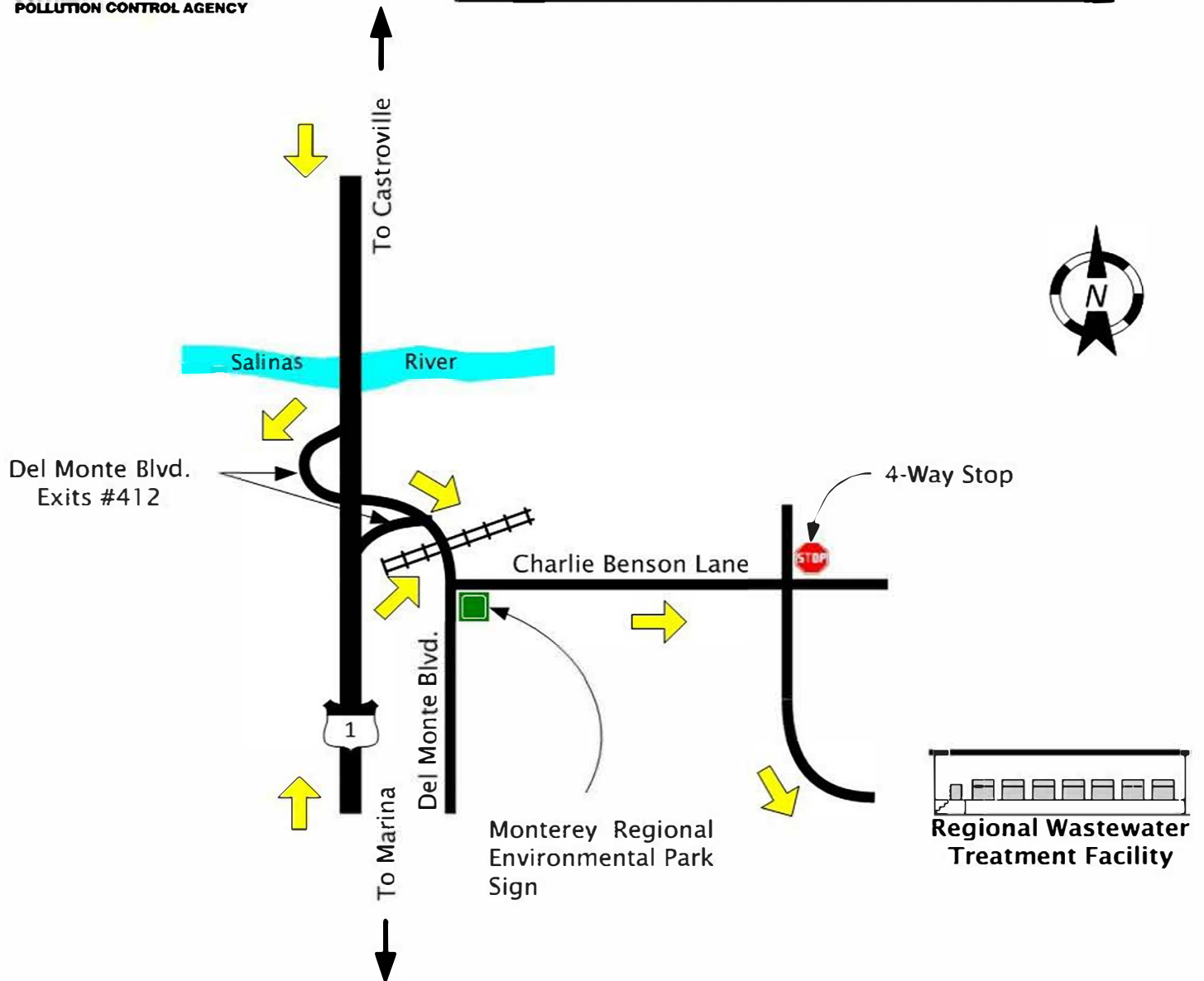

Directions to the Regional Treatment Facility



From Hwy 101:

From Hwy 101 @ Prunedale take Hwy 156 Exit. Hwy 156 turns into Hwy 1 South @ Castroville. (Continue directions from Hwy 1 South.)

From Hwy 1 South:

Go 3 miles south past Castroville. Immediately after crossing the Salinas R. bridge take the Del Monte Blvd Exit #412 & turn left over Hwy 1. Continue with directions below.

From Monterey (Hwy 1 North):

On Hwy 1 go 2 miles past Marina Take the Del Monte Blvd Exit #412 Turn right onto Del Monte Blvd. Continue with directions below.

From Del Monte Blvd:

When on Del Monte Blvd turn left after the railroad tracks at the Regional Environmental Park sign onto Charlie Benson Lane. Turn right at four way stop. Continue on road through the chain link gate. Take the second left into the parking lot. (Note: for the bus turnaround, take the third left turn and head to the flag pole.)
