
Central Coast Chapter Mission, Objectives, and Bylaws Adoption

- Improve sustainability of water resources on the Central Coast through increasing safe and beneficial water reuse.

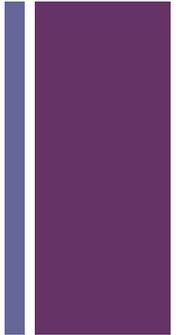
+ Objectives





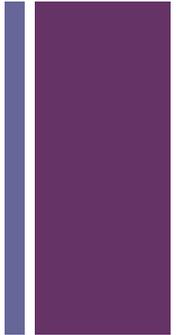
2016 WaterReuse California Annual Conference




