DIRECTIONS TO THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT



The Sacramento Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant is located at 8521 Laguna Station Road in Elk Grove, California, 95758. Please allow about 30 minutes of driving time from downtown Sacramento.

From Interstate 5:

Exit at Laguna Boulevard or Cosumnes River Blvd. and proceed east to Franklin Boulevard.....

or From State Highway 99:

Exit at Laguna Boulevard/Bond Rd. and proceed west on Laguna to Franklin Boulevard...

...Then (from north or south on Franklin Boulevard):

Head west on Sims Road and go over the railroad tracks to a stop sign. Turn right onto Laguna Station Road. Follow the road to the treatment plant's security kiosk. Park in the visitor parking area by the flagpole.
