Member Agency Studies

- ~\$3.5 million
- Same terms
- Add thematic focus

Funding Agreement with The Water Research Foundation

- ~\$1.0 million for WRF-managed studies
 - MWD-selected potable and non-potable research
- WRF funding goal: ~\$8.0 million
 - Advancing Potable Reuse Initiative
- SWRCB: \$4.5 million grant

Direct Potable Reuse	Measure pathogen variability in wastewater	\$200k
	Develop statistical methods for assessing process trains	\$125k
Indirect Potable and Non-Potable Reuse	Treatment and blending strategies for system integration	\$200k
	Optimize wastewater treatment for potable reuse	\$100k
	Develop protocols for integrating real-time sensor data	\$200k
	Evaluate indicator viruses for monitoring treatment processes and aquifer recharge	\$100k
	Address impediments to agricultural reuse	\$50k
	Seven Project Total	\$975k

Two Program Elements

Potable Reuse Funding The Water Research Foundation

- ~\$1.0 million
- Potable reuse studies
- Managed by TWRF

Member Agency Studies

- ~\$3.5 million
- Same terms
- Add thematic focus

Core Program Elements

- ~ \$3.5 million total funding
- Up to \$500k per member agency or per study
 - 100% dollar-for-dollar match
- Competitive RFP
 - Studies must meet minimum criteria
 - Member agencies prioritize their own studies
 - Selected by expert panel
- Funding is available in current and proposed budget



Brine Reduction

Proposed Enhancements

- Hold member agency meetings to solicit feedback
 - Prioritize research needs
 - Promote partnering among agencies
- Thematic focus:
 - Example: sensors
