

Jennifer West and Rich Nagel from WaterReuse California will be attending the July Chapter Meeting. WaterReuse California is actively engaged in working with our appointed and elected officials to pass legislation and develop regulations that will accelerate the implementation of both non-potable and potable reuse. The Legislative/Regulatory Committee, as well as the Managing Director, directs the Section's legislative advocate and leads all California Section activity in the state regulatory arena. West and Nagel will be updating our Chapter on recent Board activities and asking for comments and feedback from our chapter.



The Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency (PV Water) is using recycled water as a key component in its stakeholder developed program to eliminate chronic groundwater overdraft, halt seawater intrusion, and achieve a sustainable groundwater basin. Recycled water is blended with additional supplemental water supplies and delivered to coastal farmland where seawater intrusion is a serious problem affecting the quality of production wells. In 2017, PV Water constructed a 1.5 million gallon tank to store recycled water produced from nighttime inflows to the wastewater treatment plant, providing water system operators the ability to utilize the entire supply for most of the year. Brian Lockwood's presentation will focus on basin management activities in the Pajaro Valley.
