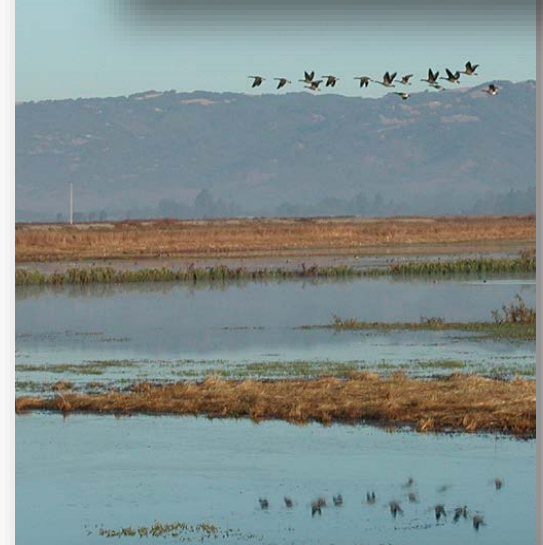

- 5 Board Officer positions:
  - President
  - Vice-President
  - Secretary/Treasurer
  - Chapter Trustee
  - Past-President
- 2-year terms
- Bimonthly Member Meetings (even months)
- Bimonthly Board Meetings (odd months)





# Primary Officer Responsibilities



## ■ **President**

- Preside over meetings
- Designates committees/appoints chairs
- (Not tied to Leg-Reg reporting)

## ■ **Vice-President**

- Chair of Meeting Committee
- Substitutes for President when needed

## ■ **Secretary/Treasurer**

- Meeting correspondence (notices, agendas, summaries)
- Official rule- and record-keeper
- No \$ to handle





# Primary Officer Responsibilities



## ■ Chapter Trustee

- Represents Chapter on the CA Section Board of Trustees
- Attends Board meetings ~ quarterly (via videoconference in Irvine & Sacramento)

## ■ Past-President

- Attends Officer Meetings
- Provides guidance
- Assists with communications, special projects

- Newsletter Committee
- Chapter Photographer
- Leg/Reg Reporting
- Bring updates from your agency/firm to Member Roundtable discussions
- Present at a meeting; contribute to newsletter
- Suggest ideas for presentation topics or meeting/chapter enhancements
