AB292 – Raw Water and Groundwater Augmentation

Author: Quirk

Status: Passed the Assembly on May 6. Ordered to inactive file* on Aug 30 after 2nd Senate reading at the request of Senator Dodd

Deletes the distinction between “direct” potable reuse and “indirect” potable reuse

- Eliminates the definition of “direct potable reuse”
- Replaces “indirect potable reuse for groundwater recharge” with “groundwater augmentation”
- Revises the definition of “treated drinking water augmentation”

**The bill may be taken up again at a later date*

AB332 – Wastewater Treatment: Recycled Water

Author: Hertzberg and Wiener

Status: In Appropriations. May 13, suspense file*.
May 16, held under submission**

Reduce ocean outfall discharge by at least

- 50% by January 1, 2030
- 95% by January 1, 2040
- \$2,000 per acre-foot penalty for failure to comply

**A bill with a fiscal impact set aside in Committee by a majority of Members present and voting. These bills may be heard at a later hearing*
