

# Climate Bond – 2022 Ballot

- Currently RW funding in SB 45 (\$100 million) and AB 1500 Garcia (\$300 million)
- WRCA requesting \$1.5 billion in funding. Joined by environmental community and many individual agencies working with Legislators.
- Developed proposed legislative language to modernize recycled water program funding program. Collaboration and support on program language from Coastkeepers and ACWA
- WRCA developing 1.5 minute "video brochure" to support funding request.



## Legislation 2021

■ AB 1434 Friedman – Sets indoor 40 GPCD -- without DWR recommendation or RW/Wastewater study public. OPPOSE

■ SB 230 Portantino – Creates
CEC Program for drinking
water at Water Board. <u>Does not</u>
duplicate RW CEC program.
SUPPORT

■ AB 377 Rivas – Requires that all surface waters attain applicable beneficial uses by 2050. <u>Under review for RW Impacts and position</u>

Groundwater Regulations Adopted (2014)

Release of DPR feasibility assessment to Legislature (2016)



### Pure Water San Diego


- The Pure Water Program will provide **nearly 1/2** of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035
- Construction for the Phase 1 projects begins this spring
- Latest information: purewatersd.org





### **East County AWP**

- Project Packages 1, 2 and 3 Progressive Design Build packages approved and moving forward with design at approx. 10-30% currently
- Project Package 4 collaborative effort between the JPA and the City of San Diego to provide the best longterm solution for the regional management of brine and centrate produced from the AWP treatment process. This Package is currently out for RFQ – closes April 14<sup>th</sup>.



## City of Escondido, MFRO for Agriculture Project

- Components include MFRO Facility, Intermediate Booster Pump Station (IBPS), and MFRO Pipeline
- Groundbreaking took place on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021!
- MFRO Pipeline is currently in construction
- 100% Design is being completed for the MFRO Facility and IBPS
