






In 2017, CUWA published a white paper that examined the impacts of declining flows



Research shows declining flows have impacts on the interconnected urban water cycle



Impacts on recycled water systems include changes in production and water quality



Of the impacted recycled water respondents, **70% indicated a decrease in recycled water production.**

*Decreases in recycled water (RW) production could be a result of various changes (e.g. decline in wastewater effluent or decline in RW demand)

**Some items included in other: decrease in recycled water influent, changes in recycled water demand.
