

WATEREUSE ARIZONA 2023 SCHOLARSHIP

WateReuse Arizona will award two (2) scholarships of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) each to Arizona university and college students. The purpose of this award is to encourage full-time students with a focus on wastewater reclamation, water reuse, and/or desalination. The scholarships will be awarded July 24, 2023 at the Arizona Water Reuse Conference in Flagstaff, Arizona.

The Mission of WateReuse Arizona is:

To promote the responsible stewardship of Arizona's water resources through education and advocacy for the best use of all water supplies.

Qualifications for Program:

- Minimum one year of college coursework completed (Sophomore, Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student)
- Full-time enrollment at an Arizona university or college for 2022-2023
- Sincere interest in pursuing a professional career related to the mission of WateReuse Arizona

Selection Criteria:

- Two or more letters of recommendation at least one must be from a college professor or college advisor. Letters must be confidential, placed in separate sealed envelopes, and not seen by student.
- Personal statement (minimum one page) stating your background and interest in the field of wastewater reclamation, water reuse, and/or desalination
- Grade point average submit college transcripts*
