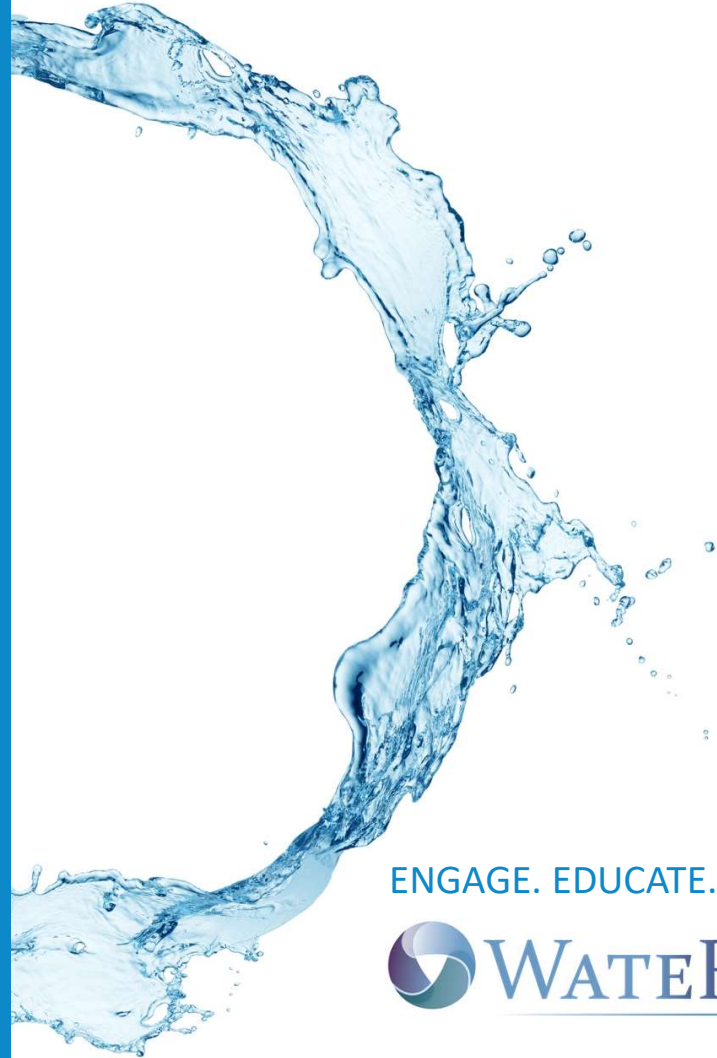

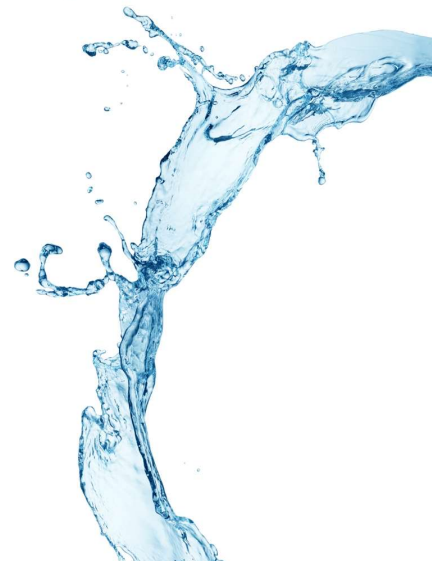

WRCA Priority: Funding



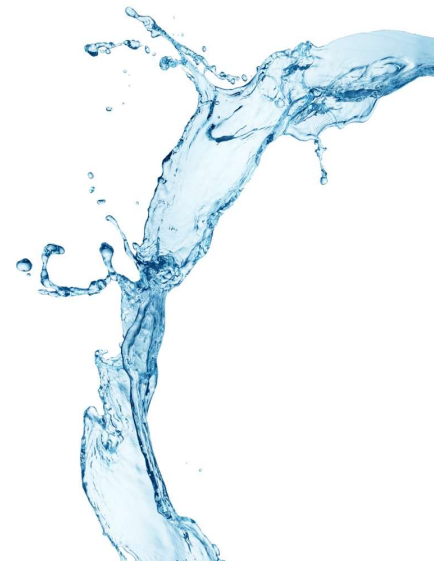
Proposition 4:

Climate Resiliency Bond
\$386M for Recycled Water
Projects out of \$3.8B for water



Water Recycling Funding
Program:

\$74.5M

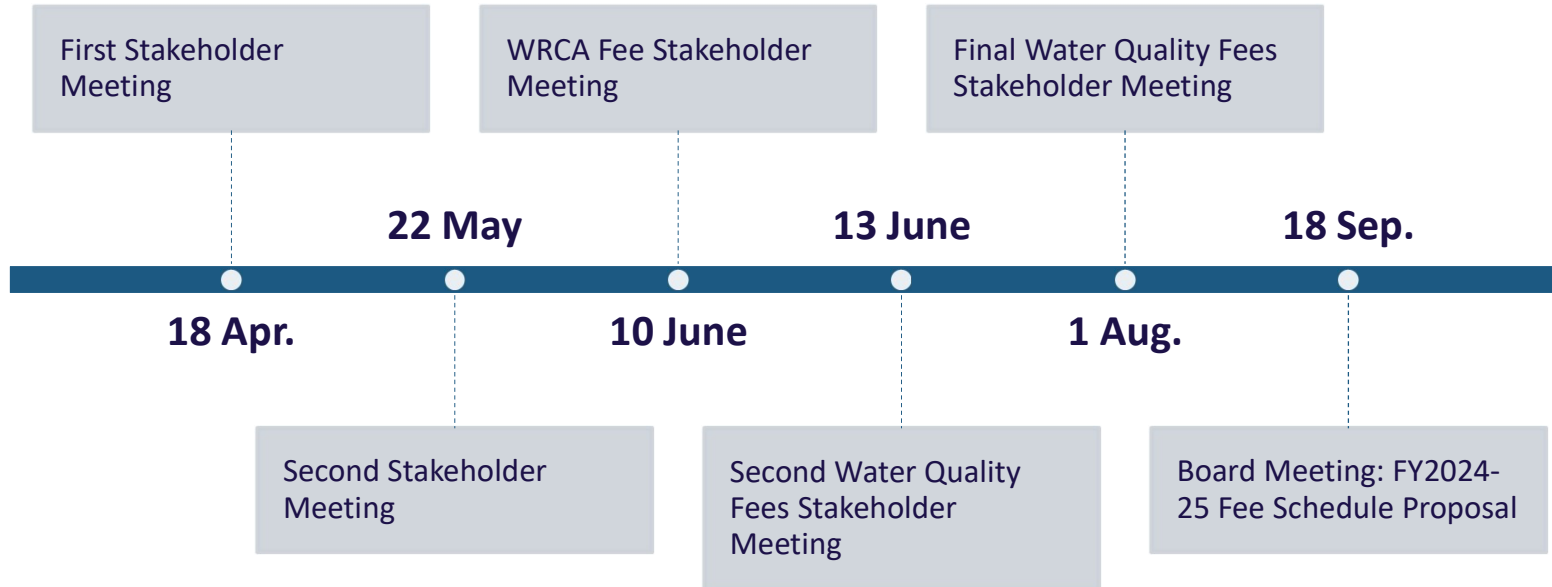


Recycled Water Permit Fees

- FY 23/24 Budget included a trailer bill to provide the fee authority of recycled water permitting
- Fees cover 15 staff for permitting recycled water projects
- Guiding Principles:
 - Remain Revenue Neutral
 - Spread the fees broadly
 - Based on relative size (actual flow from VAR)
