SVCW History

- Originally known as South Bayside System Authority
- Formed as a Joint Powers Authority in 1975
- 50-Year anniversary in November 2025
- Renamed as Silicon Valley Clean Water in 2012
- Member Agencies consist of Belmont, San Carlos, Redwood City, and West Bay Sanitary District












SVCW Service Area

- Service Area population of approx. 220,000 people
- Wastewater from Member Agencies plus Woodside and unincorporated areas of San Mateo County
- Collection systems owned and operated by Member Agencies
- SVCW operates conveyance system and plant

- 17,200 LF gravity pipeline
- 11-foot inside diameter
- \$220M




Pump Stations

- Rehab/replace five pump stations
- New gravity pipeline
- \$120M

- 80 MGD 90-foot deep •lift station
- Preliminary treatment •
- \$120M


