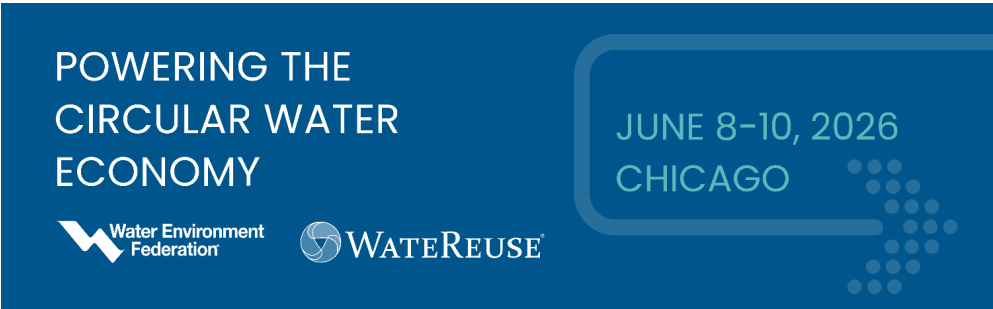

Drawing on insights from global case studies across sectors such as food and beverage, pharmaceuticals, consumer products, and energy, the session will examine four key reuse pathways—onsite reuse, offsite reuse, utility-industry partnerships, and supply chain reuse—and their technical, economic, and governance challenges. Explore barriers, partnership models, and corporate water targets through collaborative dialogue.</p>	<p><b>Circular Water Economy Framework</b>          Workshop Lead: Steve Skripnik, LimnoTech  <i>Room S 102 BC</i></p> <p>Help develop a Circular Water Economy Framework focused on practical applications for implementing circular water at the utility and industrial levels, with a particular focus on industrial water reuse. Building on ongoing discussions, the session will explore how industries can transition from linear water use toward circular approaches that prioritize reduction of waste, resource recovery, and regeneration of nature through system resilience. The workshop will provide an interactive forum to refine key framework elements, identify implementation pathways, and gather stakeholder input to help shape a vision for circular water practices across industries.</p>

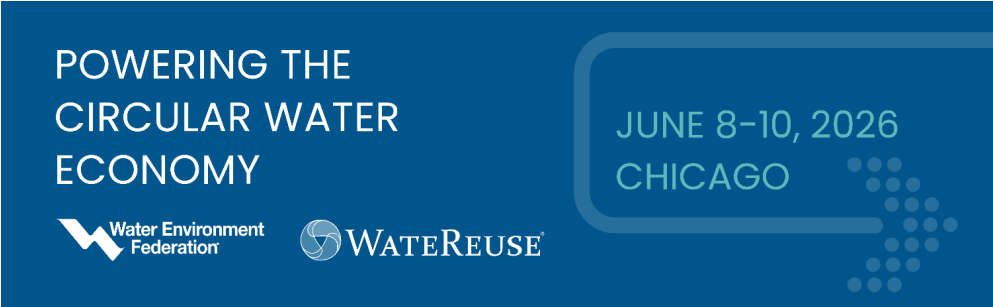
Meet at the Hyatt Regency Market Entrance on the Lobby Level. Please arrive 20 minutes before the start time.

<p><b>Stickney Water Reclamation Plant</b>  <i>Time:</i> June 8, 8:30 am – 12:00 pm</p> <p>The Stickney Water Reclamation Plant is not only the largest in the world but also the most efficient, treating an average of 700 million gallons of water per day and capable of treating up to 1.44 billion gallons per day. The plant utilizes advanced technologies to recover up to 85% of phosphorus and up to 15% of nitrogen from wastewater streams, converting them into valuable fertilizers.</p>	<p><b>Shedd Aquarium: Behind the Scenes</b>  <i>Time:</i> June 8, 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm</p> <p>The Shedd Aquarium is one of the largest indoor aquariums in the world, housing over 32,000 animals and serving as a hub for marine education and conservation. On the Behind the Scenes Tour, participants will see the aquarium’s water systems, including the water quality lab, the facilities operations room, the life support filtration systems, and the water reuse strategies that conserve water and reduce environmental impact.</p>

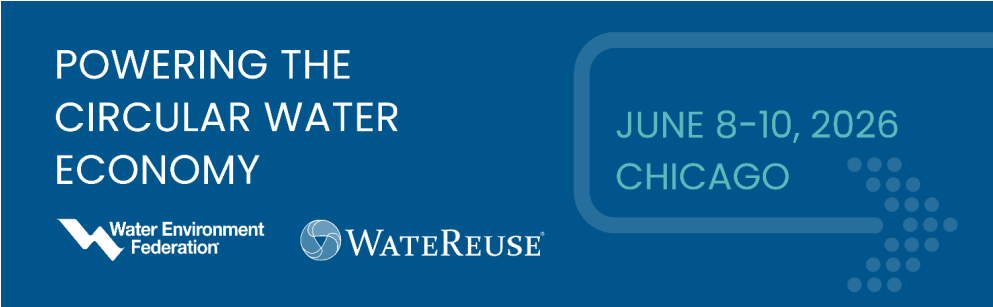

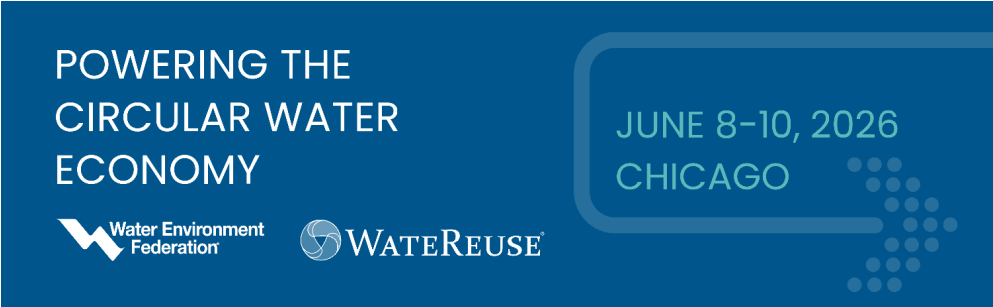
